

## Questions and Answers

1. Can you please tell me what the unit "LT" stands for on the pricing sheet?  
Are we just providing that one price? Not calculating miles on here.

**LT means LOT**

2. Can you provide an estimation of how many transports take place in a year.

**We averaged 320 trips each year (2019-2022).**

3. Do you have the following information regarding ambulance service at Sheridan VA Medical Center?

1. Ambulance run data

1. Historical run data for each month since 2019

**CY 2019 17.8 trips per month**

**CY 2020 22.0**

**CY 2021 36.2**

**CY 2022 32.0**

2. Historical BLS/ALS run data for each month since 2019

**Same as above**

3. Historical mileage data for each month since 2019

4. Historical average miles per day (per ambulance)

5. Historical min./max. number of miles per day (per ambulance)

6. Historical number of days ambulances were not in use

**Most, if not all of the ambulances at our disposal could be considered part-time and used within Sheridan for other non-VA transports.**

**Yes**

13. Is the response time requirement for Sheridan VA Medical Center only? Is there a time requirement for the other facilities within the SVHCS?

**The expectation is the contractor would provide a response for non-emergent out-of-town trips (example: Billings, Casper...etc....) of a unit availability within 30 minutes. The actual transport timeline would depend on circumstances, when the patient would be ready, the sending & receiving facility ability to release & receive patient, time of day and weather/road conditions.**

**Within Sheridan for example, interfacility between Sheridan Memorial to the Sheridan VA, would be 15 minutes to respond to our request. Deployment of the ambulance would be worked out with circumstances mentioned above factored in.**

14. Is a handheld radio satisfactory or does it need to be mounted in the truck?

**Handheld would be fine and is to be used if the Wyoming Ambulance Leads/Dispatch cannot be reached. The key is ensuring there is communication for non-business hours with the VA AOD's.**
