Under [solicitation 47QMCA21R0008](#), 2022 Light Vehicles to include Sedans, Light Trucks, & SUVs, GSA is announcing the third Open Season period for existing contractors to provide new model year (NMY) information on awarded line items, as well as for existing contractors or new interested offerors to propose new models under the 2022 Light Vehicles Program. All models must comply with the 2023 Federal Vehicle Standards 122BO and 307BB, which is available at [this link](#).

Existing contractors and new interested offerors must submit a list of all new makes/models they intend to submit for consideration to John Hampson, GSA Vehicle Engineering Branch Chief, at [john.hampson@gsa.gov](mailto:john.hampson@gsa.gov) no later than February 10, 2023, at 5:00pm EST. The subject of that correspondence should read “47QMCA21R0008 - 2023 Light Vehicles Spring Open Season Makes/Models.”

All offerors, including existing contract holders as well as new interested offerors, are also required to request an AutoBid account no later than February 10, 2023, at 5:00pm EST by submitting the attached “Request for AutoBid Account” document, complete with all necessary information, to [automotiveedi.partnerships@gsa.gov](mailto:automotiveedi.partnerships@gsa.gov). The subject of that correspondence should read “47QMCA21R0008 - 2023 Light Vehicles Spring Open Season Request for AutoBid Account.”

AutoBid will open on March 1, 2023, for all parties who properly requested an AutoBid account.
