SECTION 00010 - SOLICITATION CONTRACT FORM

The following have been added by full text:

QUESTION/ANSWERS

Question: There is a hazardous material abatement section in the specs. Is there a hazardous material survey available for B2660? If a survey is unavailable, is the contractor to assume for bidding purposes that there are no hazardous materials?

Answer: Contractors should assume the following material are hazardous.

1. Exterior siding is Cement Asbestos (tested at 40% asbestos)
2. Smokestacks and miscellaneous wood framing around stacks are clad with asbestos fireboard (untested).
3. Window frames, door frames, and casework contain lead-based paint (untested).
4. Fluorescent bulbs contain typical amounts of mercury.
5. Fluorescent fixture ballasts contain PCBs (untested, but should be labeled).

Roofing has been tested at zero percent asbestos.
