II. Nature and/or description of the action being processed.

The proposed action is for a Brand Name, new firm fixed price contract

The acquisition is for the purchase of three (3) iMX105 Refrigerators

III. Description of supplies/services required to meet agency needs.

The Pharmacy Clinic unit requires purchase of these iMX105 medication Refrigerators. The purchase of these units will enable our healthcare providers to safely obtain and administer refrigerated in-clinic medications by storing the drugs in a monitored refrigerated environment. The refrigerators being requested will have locks and will be used/must be compatible with our existing Pyxis MedStation ES medication management system to ensure medication safety and security. Pyxis MedStation system is already in-place at David Grant Medical Center. There are no other refrigerators with locks that are compatible with our existing Phyxis ES MedStations.

There are multiple vendors that can supply this the equipment. They are approved distributors for this brand name refrigerator unit.

We researched the Internet for this particular refrigerator with negative results. Additionally, our market research includes Medical Master Catalog, Prime Vendor Program, Electronic Catalog, Defense Logistics Agency, and GSA Advantage. These sources do not provide the refrigerator being requested.

VII. Determination by the Contracting Officer that the anticipated cost to the Government will be fair and reasonable.

Multiple contractors expected to proposed, the contractors will be evaluated to determine Price Fair and Reasonable based on: IGCE and other contracting data bases such as FPDSNG.

VIII. Description of the market research conducted and the results, or a statement of the reasons market research was not conducted.

A sources sought notice was posted beta.SAM.gov under NAICS 339112 from 16 Nov 22 to Dec 02 22. Three (3) vendors responded to the posting as interested, (Two Small Business and One Large).

DGMC market research also produced one small business interested.

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A GSA personnel was contacted 18 Nov 2022 for Market Research and he revealed that the items cannot be procured through GSA as their were no schedule holders with this name equipment found.

The AbilityOne procurement list and FPI was reviewed on 15 Nov 2022, and currently does not offer products that can support this requirement.

Pyxis MedStation system is already in-place at David Grant Medical Center. There are no other refrigerators with locks that are compatible with our existing Phyxis ES MedStations.
