

**STATEMENT OF WORK  
FOR  
34th WEAPONS SQUADRON HANGAR RENTAL IN SALINA, KANSAS**

**BACKGROUND:** The 34th Weapons Squadron require hangar and weapon storage rental for the Terminal Area Employment (TE) phase of the United States Air Force Weapons School (USAFWS). TE is the premier phase of the USAFWS and provides students with the opportunity to develop leadership skills in a dynamic airdrop and airland environment. This training is critical to the USAFWS HC-130J syllabus as well as combat ready aircrew. This hangar provides critical weapons storage, indoor airdrop bundle rigging space, as well as asset protection from the severe weather that is all too common in Kansas.

**1 SCOPE:** Furnish hangar space, office equipment, weapons storage bunkers and aircrew ground equipment (AGE). Provide assistance and coordination through the fixed base operator (FBO), located on the Salina Regional Airport. Services will be provided for duration of 34 WPS TE Phase execution (08 Sep 2023 – 30 Sep 2023).

**2 LOCATION:** The project site is located on the Salina Regional Airport in Salina, Kansas. Hangar 600 is located at 2734 Arnold Court, Salina, Kansas.

2.1. No work will be accomplished outside of the United States of America.

**3. DESCRIPTION OF WORK:** The work to be accomplished under this task order shall include, but is not limited to the following.

3.1. Contractor will be required to provide the hangar space (600), AGE equipment, FBO support, office equipment, gym access and support with the hangar space as required.

**4 QUALIFICATIONS:** Contractor shall provide manufactures certification of authority to repair all equipment prior to contract award.

**5. SECURITY:** The airfield maintains its own security and the weapons storage bunkers are under double lock and key. Aircrew and maintenance personnel will be provided with keys to the facilities and flightline as required.

**6. CODES:** Contractor shall maintain the facilities in accordance with their own state and local regulations.

**7. PERMITS:** Contractor shall possess or obtain all licensure and permits necessary to accomplish this statement of work.

**8. WORKING HOURS:** 34 WPS will have 24 hour access, 7 days a week during the duration of the TDY.

**9. SAFETY:** On-site staff shall comply with safety requirements as they pertain to work being accomplished. The 34 WPS will provide safety personnel as well.

**10. PROTECTION OF PERSONS AND PROPERTY:** Contractor shall be responsible for providing all personal protection (PPE) and is required to wear it when it is needed.
