**GENERAL INFORMATION**

**1.0 Background and Purpose:**

Scientists at the Roman L. Hruska U.S. Meat Animal Research Center (USMARC) are developing scientific information and new technology to solve high priority problems for the U.S. beef, sheep, and swine industries. About 50 percent of the effort is with beef cattle, 30 percent with swine, and 20 percent with sheep. Animal Carcass removal is required as part of the operations of this Center.

**CONTRACTOR REQUIREMENTS**

**2.0 Technical Requirements/Tasks:**

The contractor shall remove animal carcasses (cattle and swine) as required.

- **Swine removal will be by barrel count per year to include rendering service fees**
- **Beef removal will be categorized by calves, cattle under 30 months and cattle over 30 months. Also includes deadstock fees.**
- **Period of performance is one year after award**
- **Quantities by category listed below:**

Contractor will invoice monthly for the quantity of services performed. Total annual quantity shall not be exceeded. Government and Contractor will track quantities of services performed so as not to exceed annual totals.
