1.0 BACKGROUND

Vandenberg Space Force Base are supporting Booster Test Program efforts, which started in April 2022 and is scheduled to end in November 2024. The Program is developing a new booster configuration. Two 25K forklifts and a 40 foot flatbed trailer are required to support this mission. The Forklifts have to be at minimum 25K to perform the tasks required.

2.0 OBJECTIVES

The vendor shall supply two (2) 25K forklifts capable of lifting a maximum load of 15000 lbs and one (1) 40 foot flatbed trailer to transport equipment.

3.0 DESCRIPTION OF WORK

3.1 Installation

- Vendor shall provide two (2) 25K forklifts capable of lifting 15,000 lbs and fitted with a rubber anti-static strap that drags on the ground to dissipate static electricity.
- One (1) 25K forklift must be delivered and able to work at building 980.
- One (1) 25K forklift must be delivered and able to work at the flightline.
- One (1) 40 foot flatbed trailer must be delivered and able to transport equipment from building 980 to the flightline and back. Trailer must include 6 ea 4” Winch Strap with Flat Hook, 40 ft Long, with a Working Load Limit (WLL) of 5,400 lbs.

3.2 Operation

- The 25K forklifts must be able to lift and move the equipment as needed.
- The 40 foot flatbed trailer must be able to transport the equipment as needed.

3.2 Removal

- Rentals will remain operational until they are no longer needed to support the missions needs.
- Vendor is responsible for removing all equipment after period of operation has expired.

3.3 Supplied Items

- Vendor shall perform a full inspection and any required maintenance or repair of all material prior to delivery, even if previously provided on a residual contract.
- Vendor will supply all equipment, hardware, labor, materials, pickup & delivery
- All equipment shall be UL/ETL approved.

4.0 DESIRED SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE

- Vendor should have knowledge and ability to comply with federal, state, Air Force, local, and county laws and regulations governing the work requested in this statement.

5.0 DELIVERY TIME FRAME

- If Phase In CLIN utilized, Vendor shall deliver all equipment prior to 24 March, 2023 to designated locations.
- The vendor shall enter Vandenberg Space Force Base through the Lompoc Gate.
