

## Question and Answer Amendment

1. What is the expected frequency of waste removal or anticipated quantity?  
**Once every 2 weeks**
2. If not brand new, could you please provide the current / previous contract number?  
**FA449719P0007 (for additional data the FOIA process should be followed)**
3. What type of Medical Waste requires to be burned?  
**Non-serviceable uniforms, PPE and surgical clothes, etc**
4. The PWS refers to Bio-hazardous waste. What kind of Bio-hazardous waste?  
**Contaminated PPE with body fluids**
5. Is there a deadline to schedule a site visit?  
**No site visit planned.**
6. How should the proposal to be submitted?  
**Quotes should be submitted in accordance with the solicitation details (reference the Combined Solicitation/Synopsis Document and attachments).**
7. Clarification is requested on one point. In 1.1.3 the big states "All AFMAO pick-ups must be done separate from other facilities in a separate vehicle" It is understood that with a witness burn, there will not be any other waste on the truck because it will go directly to the disposal facility with authorized personnel to see the witness burn. For waste that does not require witness burn, can this specific truck that is servicing AFMAO be empty to make the pickup but then fill it with other waste after the pick is completed and the truck is off base?  
**For non-witness burn waste pickups, pickups may be conducted as a part of a route. However, when witness burns are required there shall be no mixing of waste with AFMAO waste and the waste shall be picked up in its own truck. View Amendment 4 Attachment 1 PWS**
8. Would AFMAO accept a service that doesn't include the burn of certain waste.  
**No; all parameters of the PWS must be met to be deemed acceptable.**
9. Would a self-use device that converts medical waste into solid, sterile trash suffice?  
**No, this requirement is for the services required to dispose of medical waste.**
10. Are there any details available on potential pick-up procedures (how to get through security, how they do the witness burn, etc)?  
**Normal base entry. (IAW para 7&8) AFMAO does not complete the witness burn, AFMAO will escort and supervise the load/unloading and burn (IAW 1.1.3)**

11. Can you confirm how many pounds/pickups they have done the previous year as well as how many witness burns? Is it twice a week or every other week?

Pounds cannot be determined as it varies based on mission, pick up every other week.

12. What is the waste type being generated? Red bag and sharps? Pathological? Trace Chemotherapy? Non-Hazardous Pharmaceutical?

Bio hazard, red bag, sharps
