War Time Fuel Requirements

1. Purpose. Related to a potential conflict with a near-peer competitor in the Pacific, USINDOPACOM and USTRANSCOM are conducting prudent planning to counter that aggression and maintain the rules-based international order by developing a wide range of bulk fuel options across the expansive INDOPACOM area of responsibility. Industry has expertise and capacity to facilitate those bulk fuel options. USTRANSCOM is hosting a Secret level USINDOPACOM-focused Industry Day at Scott AFB, IL on December 11th, 2023.

This announcement constitutes an invitation for cleared contractors to participate in USTRANSCOM's market research to determine if commercial products, commercial services, or non-developmental items are available to meet USINDOPACOM war time fuel requirements in accordance with Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) Part 10. THIS IS NOT A REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL nor is it to be construed as a commitment by the Government. The information requested will be used by USINDOPACOM, USTRANSCOM, and Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) Energy as market research to inform the DoD of commercial capabilities and will not be disclosed outside of the Government. Proprietary information shall be appropriately marked. Please note that USTRANSCOM will NOT be responsible for any costs incurred by interested parties in responding to this RFI.

2. Description/Scope. USINDOPACOM has multiple operating locations; the list of which is classified and, up to now, unknown to cleared DOD contractors. The DoD is conducting market research at the secret level to gain insight into what commercial capabilities are possible at those locations within three different time horizons: ninety days, nine months, and two years.

Organizations are invited (at their expense) to attend an Industry Day at Scott AFB on 11 December 2023, to learn the classified secret locations, participate in a group Q&A session, then be afforded the opportunity to ask questions privately with government representatives. After Industry Day, organizations are welcome to submit additional information about their abilities related to improving the bulk fuel capabilities in the Pacific.

Industry Day will start with a welcome from USTRANSCOM leadership and a classified Secret overview of the operating locations followed by an opportunity to ask clarifying questions in a group setting. Organizations will then be granted 30-minute sessions to ask questions privately of key government representatives from USINDOPACOM, USTRANSCOM, and DLA Energy. Based on need, additional 30-minute time slots for questions may be held on 12 & 13 December 2023 to accommodate interest. Time slots will be assigned by USTRANSCOM and are non-negotiable.

Industry Day will be held at the Force Flow Conference Center, Scott AFB, Illinois on 11 December 2023 from 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM. Exact location and directions will be sent in the Welcome packet after participants register. Additional days are possible based on the number of responses.
