Statement of work

The work that will be done on the John Deere tractor will included:

- Multi point inspection
- Test and record horsepower with dynamometer
- Clean inside and outside of the tractors and wax them
- Check the Hydraulic system and check the hydraulic oil and filter
- Check Engine Mount and frame bolts
- Check Operator Station Functions
- Check all fluids level
- Check and repairs Air filter if needed
- Check Air conditioner condenser and clean out if dirty and if the tractor has Air Conditioner on it
- Road Test to check operation of all gears in the transmission
- Check Rear Axle Bearings
- Check for any Hydraulic leaks
- Check Operation of Right and Left Brakes
- Check Steering Right and Left turns
- Change the Motor Oil and Filters

If the mechanic finds anything that not working right or broke. They will get the parts and fix the problem, so the tractor is work right and ready for the season.

Greenway will pick up and bring back the tractors after they are done servicing and repairs on all the tractors.

The 3720 needs a door pin.

The 5220 with forks has a leak around the front left wheel.

The 6400 needs the AC looked at not cooling good.
