

Q./ Will, and how often will our techs have access to service unit?

A./ Tentatively once every two weeks.

Q./ It is noted that there is no water-service/hydrants to provide water. Is there a septic/sewer system for disposal of grey/shower water?

A./ No.

Q./ Is electric available at shower site?

A./ Yes.

Q./ Will you guys have your own power/water supply for this set up at the FW airport or do we need to factor that in as well?

A./ Electric yes, water no, we looked all around the area where the FD would be staying and there's no water spigots, etc.

Q./ When are you looking to start? The reason is that I have just being informed that the ones rented to Amazon over froze from the weather. I am trying to find out if we need it the winter months or later. Also, the issue water not being on site, no hydrant close by, anything to support the service because the tank cannot be mixed with any chemical since it's for shower.

A./ It should be sometime between the 20th-27th of March and lasting at least until mid to late June, is what we are currently expecting.

Q./ Also, things I would need to assist with the rental as requested are, is the area for placement solid, do you have electrical and standard 3/4" water hose connection to hook up the trailer? Is there a power outlet close by the location where the trailer would be located? I have been able to clear most of the request except the above, also it is highly recommended that the rental term is specific like 3 months or 6 months as this would help with the pricing sir.

A./ The area for placement would be solid (asphalt/concrete parking lot). There would not be any water hookups and we believe we will only have an electrical connection for power. I don't have the distance yet because we need better trailer specs and to have another conversation with the site to determine where the placement will be finally located. The term we are expecting currently is 3 months with the option to extend it out as needed, in a weekly/monthly increment.

Q./ The sources sought simply stated shower skid, did you intend it comes with a restroom too? I think it would be better to have a restroom combo on same trailer.

A./ We are open to a trailer that has a bathroom installed as well, if that helps things. However, they will have restroom access and just need a shower for personnel operating 24-hour shifts. So, in short, it is optional but not required.

We do understand there are various trailer options that may be available though and looking for all solicitations to determine what will work best for them.
