This is a combined synopsis/solicitation for commercial items prepared in accordance with the format in FAR Subpart 12.6, as supplemented with additional information included in this notice. This announcement constitutes the only solicitation; proposals are being requested and a written solicitation will not be issued.

Solicitation number FA822723R1113 is issued as a request for quote (RFQ) and incorporated provisions and clauses are those in effect through Federal Acquisition Circular 2023-02 and its supplements.

This is a 100% Small Business Set-Aside announcement filed under NAICS code 333120 and Product Service Code 3805. This requirement is to purchase brand name accessories for a Government owned Bobcat T64 Compact Track Loader to meet test mission requirements for the 309 Missile Maintenance Group (MMXG)/Minot 583rd Missile Maintenance Squadron (MMXS). The Government intends to award a Brand Name, Firm Fixed Price to an authorized distributor of Bobcat products in accordance with FAR 13.501, see Brand Name Justification attached to this solicitation.
