

NCSU Propane

1. PROJECT TITLE: NCSU Propane Services
2. BACKGROUND/PURPOSE: The Northern Cheyenne Service Unit (NCSU), Lame Deer, Montana, serves patients who live on the Northern Cheyenne Indian Reservation. The clinic operates in a 65,000 square foot building and 21 residential houses that use propane for heat and hot water. Environmental temperature regulation of facilities is critical to the IHS mission.
3. SCOPE: The vendor shall supply propane to the clinic and government housing on a continuous basis where it will be used for heat and hot water in government quarters and the clinic.
4. APPLICABLE DOCUMENTS: Regulatory Bodies and Tariffs may apply.
5. TASKS:
 - A. Deliver propane to the Northern Cheyenne Clinic, one - 18,000 gallon tank
 - B. Deliver propane to 21 government residential quarters with 500 gallon tanks
6. DELIVERABLES AND DELIVERY SCHEDULE: The deliverable will be propane delivery continuous for 12 months each contract year.
7. PLACE OF PERFORMANCE: Northern Cheyenne Service Unit; Lame Deer, Montana & Government Quarters
8. PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE: February 1, 2023 through January 31, 2024 with four (4) option years:
