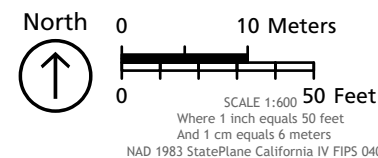

This map shows elevation dimensions at two washouts along the Ash Mountain waste water treatment plant ponds. GPS data was collected in the standard NPS NAD83 coordinate system and converted to State Plane for interoperability with CAD. A vertical transformation of 95.975 ft was also applied to the GPS altitude to convert to a geometric height.
