

**PERFORMANCE WORK STATEMENT

**1. Description of Services.** The contractor shall provide all personnel, equipment, tools, materials, supervision, transportation, and other items and services necessary to support the lease of refrigeration and or freezer trailers at Air Force Mortuary Affairs Operations Center. Number of trailers will be dictated by mission requirements.

**1.1. Specific Functions.** Transportation to and from lease site, physical positioning and set up of refrigerated trailer units to be leased monthly. Units will be used to store human remains.

## **2. Trailer Specifications:**

2.1. Outside container specifications: 45 feet long, 12 feet and 6 inches high, and 8 feet wide. Two panel rear doors that swing out and open fully.

2.2. Inside Container specifications: 44 feet long, 8 feet high, 7 feet and 7 inches wide.

2.3. Electric “plug-in” with automatic temperature control. Electric will be 215 to 240 volt, 3 phase, using a separate 60 amp circuit breaker. No fuses. A 6 gauge, 4 wire power line will be used for distances less than 100ft. Distances greater than 100 feet will require a 6 gauge, 4 wire power line. Trailer length will be used in calculating power line distance. Electrical connection box will be at the front of the trailer. The actual power connection will be made by 436<sup>th</sup> Civil Engineers.

2.4. On-site maintenance and repair. The contractor shall provide on-site maintenance and repair within 4 hrs of notification. This includes evening, weekends and holidays.

3. Contractor will deliver trailer within 24 hours of request (includes evening, holiday and weekends).

4. Pickup of trailers will be scheduled during normal business hours (no evenings, weekends, or holidays).

5. Contractor will ensure all applicable state licensing and insurance laws are adhered to.

## **3. Security:**

3.1. All personnel employed by the contractor in the performance of this contract, or any representative of the contractor entering the government installation shall abide by all security instructions and directives of Dover AFB. Employees are responsible for safeguarding all government property provided for contractor use.

3.2. At the close of each work period, government facilities, equipment and materials shall be secured, lights, heat and water turned off and all doors and windows secured.

3.3. The contractor and as applicable, subcontractor shall not employ persons for work on this contract if such employees is identified as a potential threat to the health, safety, security, and/or general well-being or operational mission of the installation and its population. Nor shall the contractor or subcontractor employ persons under this contract who have an outstanding criminal warrant as identified during the Criminal Background Check (CBI).

3.4. Contractors shall ensure their employees and those of their subcontracts have the proper credentials allowing them to work in the United States. Employees and subcontractors later found to be undocumented or illegal aliens will be remanded to the proper authorities.

3.5. All contractors and subcontractors when working in a Controlled, Restricted or other sensitive areas must be escorted at all times. The military agency or unit responsible for the project or work is responsible for providing the escorts. The Contractor shall follow existing procedures and instructions for obtaining entrance to restricted or controlled.

3.6. All personnel employed by the contractor must sign a non-disclosure statement prior to performing under this contract.

**4. Health and Safety:** The contractor shall comply with the safety standards of the Air Force Occupational Health and Safety Standards (AFOSH) and any health and safety clauses incorporated in this contract.

**5. Hours of Operation:** Building 116 will be available for the vendor from Monday through Friday, 0800 – 1500, excluding federal holidays. By appointment for maintenance and repair.

**6. Government Furnished Equipment and Facilities:** Trailer space and electrical supply to refrigeration/freezer trailer.
