MISSION SUPPORT Waterway Security

U.S. AIR FORCE

Mission Owner: 11th Security Forces Squadron

Stakeholders: Joint Base Anacostia-Bolling

SCOPE: JBAB is seeking out industry's assistance with developing recommended enhanced Force Protection security for coverage along the base western perimeter of the Potomac River (Naval Research Lab to the Frederick Douglas Bridge). Coverage may include above or submerged sensor systems to tie in with the installation's Command and Control system/camera system, fencing, and/or any other recommended hardened/soft barriers.

The waterway security system supports the mission with alarm annunciations and visual identification of potential penetration/breach attempts of the waterfront/installation perimeter.



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MISSION SUPPORT Explosive Detection

SCOPE: JBAB is seeking out industry's assistance in increasing security measures with more effective explosive detection equipment at the installation access control points. The equipment is to detect not only visible and easily detectable explosives, but also non-visible and indiscernible advanced explosives such as Improvised Explosive Devices, which consist of chemicals in either solid, liquid, or gaseous form.

Explosive detection equipment would aid in the safeguarding of 70+ mission partners and the 17K personnel who live and/or work on the installation. The equipment would lessen the potential for attacks by increasing detection with rapid processing time in the absence of explosive detection military working dogs. An explosive detection equipment is advantageous for both installation security as well as counter-terrorism applications.

SCOPE: Joint Base Anacostia-Bolling (JBAB), as well as the National Capital region, has seen a rise in electric vehicles (EV) on the roadways. In anticipation of this increase, as well as foreseen DoD energy mandates, JBAB will require the install of numerous EV charging stations throughout the base. 11 CES seeks local companies that have experience with electric vehicle infrastructure construction and implementation who can teach about existing technologies and infrastructure support. Specifically, 11 CES seeks information pertaining to electrical infrastructure requirements, communications requirements, and how the base can charge personnel for personal use of EV charging stations.

Joint Base Anacostia Bolling (JBAB) is in southwest Washington D.C and there are 14k vehicles that commute to base daily. Not only does this mean that the base requires well maintained roadways and parking lots to accommodate personnel, but it also needs to begin planning for personal electric vehicles and the construction of charging stations. According to an article written in October 2022, *DOD Prototyping EV Charger for Fleet, Personal Vehicles*, the DOD is piloting the installation of modern EV charging stations in anticipation for EV increase. JBAB would like to be ahead of the curve and begin researching the requirement now.

SCOPE: Non-personal commercial services of School Bus Transportation Services for Joint Base Anacostia-Bolling (JBAB) in Washington, D.C. The Contractor shall furnish all labor, supervision, management, tools, materials, equipment, school buses, transportation, incidental engineering, and other items necessary to provide school bus transportation services for approximately 394 school age children for JBAB to schools. The buses shall not be older than ten years and shall be compliant with all Federal, State, County, and municipal laws, statutes, ordinances, rules, and regulations.

This critical service provides pick-up and drop-off services to transport children living in Base Housing on Joint Base Anacostia-Bolling to their respective District of Columbia Public and/or Charter Schools, which is a privilege, not a right. Transportation is also available to dependents of Active Duty or Department of Defense (DoD) civilian personnel in grades Kindergarten through 12th grade residing in military housing in the DC area. Military housing in the DC area includes: JBAB, the Navy Yard, Ft. McNair, and the Marine Barracks.

Support includes one (1) Pool Manager and/or one (1) Assistant Manager and six (6) Lifeguards for open swim; and one (1) Pool Manager and/or one (1) Assistant Manager and three (3) Lifeguards for lap swim. In addition will provide a daily/weekly maintenance and cleaning of the Aquatic Center and its grounds.

Service should include cleaning of the pond by draining and providing safe handling of the fish, light pressure wash of the interior of the pond rocks, etc. Removal of any debris, replacement /cleaning of filter, cleaning of the pump and skimmers box, re-filling of the pond after cleaning and treatment with proper chemicals to limit algae growth, test the water for proper conditioning and to ensure the pond is operating as it should be.
