Therefore, the offeror's initial offer should contain the offeror's best terms from a price and technical standpoint. The Government reserves the right to conduct discussions if the Contracting Officer later determines them to be necessary. The Government may reject any or all offers is such action is in the public interest; accept other than the lowest offer; and waive informalities and minor irregularities in offers received.The award will be made to the lowest priced technically acceptable quote/proposal. Quotes/Proposals will be evaluated for technical acceptability but will not be ranked using the non-price Factors (and Subfactors).

c. Evaluation Criteria. Evaluation criteria consists of factors. The quotes will be evaluated under two (2) evaluation factors: Technical Capability,and Price.

Factor 1 – Technical Factor. The Technical Factor will receive one of the ratings defined below.

Table 1. Technical Capability Acceptable/Unacceptable Ratings	
Rating	Description
Acceptable	Quote clearly meets the minimum requirements of the solicitation.
Unacceptable	Quote does not clearly meet the minimum requirements of the solicitation.

In order to receive an acceptable rating, the technical factor submissions must demonstrate technical capability in the same or similar magnitude and complexity outlined in the Statement of Work.

Factor 2 – Price. Price will be scored or rated. Evaluation of price will be performed using one or more of the price analysis techniques in FAR 13.106-3(a). Through these techniques the Government will determine whether prices are reasonable.

d. A written notice of award or acceptance of an offer, mailed or otherwise furnished to the successful offeror within the time for acceptance specified in the offer, shall result in a binding contract without further action by either party. Before the offer's specified expiration time, the Government may accept an offer (or part of an offer), whether or not there are negotiations after its receipt, unless a written notice of withdrawal is received before award.
