

Acceptable Identity Documents

Credential Type	Notes
US Passport or Passport Card	Sole Source Document; must be unexpired
Certificate of Naturalization (N-550 or N-570)	Sole Source Document
Permanent Residency Card (I-551)	Sole Source Document; must be unexpired
Foreign Passport with temporary (I-551) or temporary (I-551) printed notation on a machine readable immigrant visa	Sole Source Document; must be unexpired OR within one year of date of issuance if no expiration date is listed
An Immigration and Naturalization Service Employment Authorization Document (I-766)	Form must include photograph to be used as a sole source document; must be unexpired
Real ID-compliant Driver's License or Non-Driver Identification Card	Sole Source Document; must be unexpired
Enhanced Driver's License (EDL)	Sole Source Document; must be unexpired EDLs are only issued by Michigan, Minnesota, New York, Vermont, and Washington.
Merchant Mariner Card/Credential	Sole Source Document; must be unexpired
Personal Identity Verification (PIV) card issued by the Federal government	Sole Source Document; must be unexpired
Personal Identity Verification-Interoperable (PIV-I) issued by non-Federal government entities	Sole Source Document; must be unexpired
DHS Trusted Traveler Cards (Global Entry, NEXUS, SENTRI, FAST)	Sole Source Document; must be unexpired
Border Crossing Card (DSP-150)	Sole Source Document; must be unexpired
U.S. refugee travel document, or other travel document or evidence of immigration status issued by DHS containing a photograph	Sole Source Document; document will be reviewed and verified on a case-by-case basis.
Non-REAL ID-compliant driver's license/non-driver identification card	Must be used in conjunction with one of the following: Veteran's Health Identification Card Transportation Worker Identification Card Birth Certificate AND Social Security Card
Native American Tribal Identification Card	Sole Source Document; must be unexpired
Army Survivor Card	Sole Source Document Valid unless explicitly revoked
Non-CAC Local or Regional DoD Credential (LRC)	LRCs must be machine-readable, unexpired, and enrolled in IMESA (e.g. DBIDS, AIE)
