The 90th Contracting Squadron is issuing this combined synopsis/solicitation, FA461323Q1038, as a Request for Quote using FAR Part 12, Acquisition of Commercial Item, & FAR Part 13, Simplified Acquisition Procedures.

The Government intends to award a Firm Fixed-Price Commercial Award. The solicitation document and incorporated provisions and clauses are those in effect through the Federal Acquisition Regulation FAC Number **2023-05 effective 7 September 2023**, Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement Change Number DFARS Change **08/17/2023** and Department of the Air Force Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement Change Number DAFAC 2023-0707 effective 7 July 2023.

Must meet the following minimum requirements/specifications:

- 30' x 80' (2,400 sq ft) once erected
- Floor plan layout shall be reconfigurable
- Height Clearance shall be between 80-84"
- Shall contain minimum of 5 Left Swing, 5 Right swing doors, & 7 open door panels
- Shall contain minimum of 4 window panels with a minimum 2' X 2' window openings and reinforced framing
- Shall be constructed to withstand non-lethal small arms munitions or simunitions
- Structure shall be free standing
- "DO NOT FIRE ABOVE THIS LINE" shall be on the top of every panel (Painted or Decal-ed) in red
- Structure material, to primarily include walls, shall be made of a **water-proof, non-ballistic material (rubbers, plastics, or other polymers will suffice. Wood or cellulose products will not fulfill this requirement)**
- Shall be easily erected/taken down/transported to alternate training locations by no more than 2 personnel in 3 hours
- Structure shall be durable and withstand direct, aggressive, physical contact with personnel
- Shall have connection joints at the top and bottom of the panels/walls with robust hardware to prevent movement when struck
- Shall be able to withstand heavy wind up to 40 mph and Wyoming weather conditions when moved outdoors
- Capable of creating a minimum of 5 individual rooms
- Structure shall be capable of creating separately on straight, near full length, hallway, and L & T hallway intersection at a minimum width of 3'
- The structure shall be a hard wall system that is durable and capable of withstanding direct, aggressive, physical contact with personnel and rough outdoor environment
- Shall have at least a 2-year warranty

FAR 52.212-1 (ADDENDUM)

Instructions to Offerors—Commercial Products and Commercial Services (March 2023)

FAR 52.212-1 is hereby tailored as follows:

- (m)(1) Any inconsistency between FAR Provision 52.212-1 and the Addendum to FAR 52.212-1 shall be resolved by giving precedence to the Addendum to FAR 52.212-1.
- (2) After receipt of quotes, the Government may, with or without notice, negotiate with and, if desired, seek quote revisions from as many or as few quoters as it, in its discretion, deems appropriate.
- (3) The term “offeror” or “offer” as used in FAR 52.212-1 shall be understood to mean “quoter” and “quote,” respectively. Further, the term “award” shall be understood to describe the Government’s issuance of an order.
- (4) The Government will consider all quotes that are timely received and may consider late quotes. Failure of a quote to address any items required as stated in this RFQ may make a quote unacceptable and ineligible for award.
- (5) Paragraph (b) of FAR Provision 52.212-1, Submission of Offers, is amended as follows:
- (n) In addition to the quote submission requirements stated in FAR provision 52.212-1, quoters shall provide the following no later than the required time and date stated above for quote submission:

- (1) Price quote shall identify all requested items; price quote must include unit prices inclusive of shipping and extended amounts. Total amount of CLIN 0001 shall include ALL costs, including delivery, loading and unloading associated with CLIN 0001.

- (3) Delivery must be completed no later than 180 days after receipt of award
- (4) Completed pages 1 and 2 of this RFQ

EVALUATION CRITERIA: Award decision will be based upon the offer representing the lowest priced technically acceptable offer to the government as stated below.

- (a) The Government will award a contract resulting from this solicitation/RFQ to the responsible offeror whose offer conforming to the solicitation will be most advantageous to the Government, price and other factors considered. Award decision will be based upon the offer representing the **lowest priced technically acceptable** to the Government in accordance with FAR 8.405-1(f) and the following factors:
 - 1) Technical Factor
 - i. Meets the Government requirements/specifications as stated above on CLIN 0001
 - ii. Submit all DELIVERABLES as listed above under FAR 52.212-1
 - iii. Descriptive literature showing item meets the required specifications listed above

 - 2) Price Factor

Award will be made to the lowest priced technically acceptable offer. No additional information from the offeror will be required if the price is based on adequate price competition. In the event adequate price competition does not exist, the contracting officer will obtain information from the offeror to the extent required to determine the reasonableness of the offered prices.
 - 3) The Government will evaluate quotes for acceptability, but will not rank the quotes by the non-price factors. If the Government receives fewer than three (3) initial quotes, all quotes will be evaluated for Technical Acceptability. If the Government receives three or more initial quotes, the Government will only select the three (3) lowest priced quotes and then evaluate them for Technical Acceptability. The Government reserves the right to evaluate additional quotes for technical acceptability if it is in the Government's best interest to do so.
- (b) DELETED
- (c) A written notice of award or acceptance of an offer, mailed or otherwise furnished to the successful offeror within the time for acceptance specified in the offer, shall result in a binding contract without further action by either party. Before the offer's specified expiration time, the Government may accept an offer (or part of an offer), whether or not there are negotiations after its receipt, unless a written notice of withdrawal is received before award.
