This is a 100% Set-Aside for Small Business.

SALIENT CHARACTERISTICS

1. This equipment is a requirement to ensure the safety of the aircraft from environmental hazards as prescribed in AFI 21-101 ACCSUP & AFI 21- 103 sect 3.8.
2. The requirement consists of complete sets of aircraft safety covers for 25 aircraft:

- a. Qty: 28 – F-15 Folding Intake 6” Foam Plug--serves to deter the introduction of foreign objects, precipitation, and wildlife into the intake of the turbine engines of the F-15E.
- b. Qty: 28 – F-15 Folding Exhaust 6” Foam Plug--serves to deter the introduction of foreign objects, precipitation, and wildlife into the exhaust of the turbine engines of the F-15E.
- c. Qty: 29 – F-15E Intake Cover--serves to deter the introduction of foreign objects, precipitation, and wildlife into the intake of the turbine engines of the F-15E during extended periods of aircraft nonuse.
- d. Qty: 26 – F-15 HUD Cover--serves to deter the introduction of foreign objects, precipitation, and wildlife into, as well as prevents physical damage of the Heads-Up Display of the F-15E.
- e. Qty: 74 – F-15 Ejection Seat Pitot Covers--serves to deter the introduction of foreign objects, precipitation, and wildlife into, as well as prevents physical damage of the critical airspeed sensing equipment of the two ejection seats outfitted into the F-15E.
