The 60th Contracting Squadron is seeking sources for items on Travis AFB

INTRODUCTION:

This is a SOURCES SOUGHT to determine the availability of businesses to include small businesses (including the following subsets, Small Disadvantaged Businesses, HUB Zone Firms, Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Businesses, and Woman Owned Small Business) and large business concerns to provide the required products.

Travis AFB is seeking sources to provide an Interacoustic Titan that provides impedance measurements to support ENT clinic and newborn hearing screening capabilities for the Audiology Clinic. This equipment shall also provide mobile impedance and OAE (Otoacoustic Emissions) functionality, and ABRIS (Auditory Brainstem Response Infant Screening) feature allows for automated Auditory Brainstem Response (ABR) testing for infants.

The contractor shall provide this product in accordance with the standards specified in this contract and in accordance with the Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) Specifications, the National Fire Protection Association Standard NFPA 99 (Electrical Equipment in Healthcare Facilities), the Bureau of Radiological Health (BRH), Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPPA) IAW 45CFR 160 and 164, and the Joint Commission for Accreditation of Health Care Organizations (JCAHO). Responses to this notice should include company name, address, point of contact, Cage Code, size of business pursuant to North American Industrial Classification System (NAICS) 339112: Surgical and Medical Instrument Manufacturing.
