DEFINITIVE RESPONSIBILITY CRITERIA

In addition to examining the criteria in FAR 9.104-1, the Contracting Officer will also examine whether the low bidder can meet the one (1) definitive responsibility criteria, in accordance with FAR 9.104-2. The apparent low bidder will be required to meet the following experience requirements:

Within the past ten years, have experience in painting steel structures, using the specified USACE 3-A-Z vinyl paint system (09 97 02, Sect. 3.6). Such experience must be demonstrated through at least one (1), but not more than three (3), construction contracts.

If a Bidder wishes to receive credit for the experience of a subcontractor, the Bidder must submit a letter of commitment to use the proposed subcontractor on the project, signed both by the subcontractor and the Bidder. The subcontractor must be projected to play a substantial role in contract performance and this role shall be indicated in the parties' letter referenced above.

The Contracting Officer will verify the submitted projects meet the definitive responsibility criteria as part of the responsibility determination. Bidders are not required to submit additional documentation related to these criteria at the time of bid but may elect to submit the necessary information with their bid package and are encouraged to do so in the interest of time and efficiency.

Bidders are not penalized for not doing so, nor rated on any information provided. If responsibility information is provided with the bid package, it should be in a separate email attachment marked "Responsibility Information", and it will not be opened or reviewed prior to establishment of the apparent low bidder. If not included in the bid package, the required information must be provided to the Contracting Officer within two business days after bid opening.

The graphic format, color, size and typefaces used on the sign are to be reproduced exactly as specified below. The title with First Aid logo in the top section of the sign and the performance record captions are standard for all signs of the type. Legend Groups 2 and 3 below identify the project and the contractor and are to be placed on the sign as shown.


Safety record numbers are mounted on individual metal plates and are screw mounted to the background to allow for daily revisions to posted safety performance record.


