1.0 INTRODUCTION

Brookhaven Science Associates, LLC (herein known as "BSA"), operator of Brookhaven National Laboratory (BNL) under a Prime Contract with the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) herewith solicits your quote for a 16 Mpix 9 μ m sCMOS EUV Camera for Soft X-ray Spectroscopy to BNL specifications as outlined in Enclosure 1, Draft Purchase Order 421992.

2.0 SCOPE OF WORK

The Offeror shall configure one (1) 16 Mpix 9 μ m sCMOS EUV Camera for Soft X-ray Spectroscopy to BNL specifications in strict accordance with Enclosure 1, Draft Purchase Order 421992.

3.0 FORMS OF QUOTATION AND MANNER OF SUBMISSION

A complete quotation, including the signed Quotation Pricing Sheet, must be received by BSA no later than **5:00 p.m. EST on November 30, 2022**. Any offer received after this time and date may not be considered. Award is expected to be made on or about **December 15, 2022**. Quotations will be opened in private. Quotations, including their withdrawal or modification, received after the closing date shall be considered late. Such responses will only be considered for award if it is in BSA's best interest to do so.

BSA prefers electronic submissions of formal quotations. Electronic submissions will be accepted by the following method:

- Email submissions must include a scanned copy of the signed Quotation Pricing Sheet. Emails will be sent to bfurlow@bnl.gov with the BSA RFQ Number in the Subject Line.

4.0 PRICING AND SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION

4.1 Pricing Quotation and Supporting Documentation.

The offeror shall complete and return the Quotation Pricing Sheet attached to this document. Prices shall be quoted in U.S. dollars, FOB, Brookhaven National Laboratory, Upton, Long Island, New York (freight included) including any Import Duties, customs and associated costs, if applicable.

4.2 System For Award Management (SAM):

In order to support DOE reporting requirements, BSA requires all its vendors/contractors to be registered in the U. S. Government supplier database entitled System For Award Management (SAM). Registration can be performed on line at www.sam.gov. If not already registered, please register as soon as possible since failure to do so may preclude BSA from doing business with your organization. Please note that there is no charge for SAM registration. When registering, you are strongly urged to copy and paste www.sam.gov onto your browser address rather than utilizing your search engine. Utilizing your search engine may redirect you to an erroneous site. By signing the attached Quotation Pricing Sheet, AMS Form-043, it shall be assumed that your firm is registered in SAM. Foreign firms may register in SAM.gov as well, if your firm chooses not to register, you must complete the attached AMS Form-50.

BSA will make award to the responsive and responsible offeror who submits the lowest total price and who meets all of BSA's technical requirements.

The resultant agreement shall be subject to the terms and conditions of Enclosure 1.
