

Question and Answer

Q: I wanted to clarify the type of hay you are looking for, are you wanting a prairie hay? Straight brome won't work?

A: We are looking for a mixed grass hay with two or more types. We have used a prairie hay on a regular basis previously, but a brome/orchard or timothy would work as well. We have used a straight single type if needed, but with the large variety of different species of animals that will be consuming, a mixed blend tends to meet the need better.

Note: The types of hay considered to be acceptable are included in the technical requirement of the solicitation description posted to SAM.gov and on the Statement of Work (SOW) included in the attachments to the solicitation on SAM.gov (pages 7-9).

*As this solicitation was posted as a 100% Total Small Business Set-Aside under the NAICS 111490 (Hay Farming) with a small business size standard of \$2.5 Million, you must qualify as a small business concern for this NAICS code to be able to be put into consideration for award should you submit a quote.
