Pre-Solicitation Questions and Answers dated 29 August 2022.

Question #6: Will all of the work/projects be exclusive to on base or do you anticipate any projects on the air side as well?

**Answer #6: The work/projects will be on Fairchild AFB and at associated tenant units off base such as the JPRA training academy and Survival School.**

Question #7: Do you have any information that you can share on what type of projects are anticipated under this contract?

**Answer #7: Please refer to the service description in the pre-solicitation synopsis as these are the types of projects we anticipate to award under this contract.**

Question #8: The solicitation states that it is limited to small businesses. Does this apply to consultants as well or only the prime?

**Answer #8: For this solicitation, only the prime contractor is required to be a small business.**

Question #9: Are PPQs/CPARs required? If yes, would they count against the 50-page limit? If not required, can we include them in an Appendix/Index (without counting against the 50-page limit) to highlight our firm's "[Evaluation Factor No. 2] Past performance on contracts with Government agencies and private industry in terms of cost control, quality of work and compliance with performance schedules"?

**Answer #9: No, PPQs (Past Performance Questionnaires) and CPARs (Contractor Performance Assessment Reports) are not required. If provided, they would count against the 50-page limit. Packages are limited to 50 pages each, exclusive of indexing tabs, project photos or drawings with brief captions.**

Question #10: When evaluating the Example Projects for Part I Section F, would a past project located in the general geographical area of Fairchild AFB (per Evaluation Factor No. 3) be graded higher (and/or be considered more relevant) than a past project located outside of the geographical area, given all other factors being equal?

**Answer #10: Per the evaluation criteria listed on the pre-solicitation synopsis "Submissions received in response to this notice will be evaluated by a board of professional engineers, architects and others in strict compliance with FAR Part 36.6 and PL 92-582 (Brooks A-E Act) with the following evaluation criteria. The evaluation criteria are listed in descending order of importance".**

Question #11: What is the small business size standard for this one? I see \$22.5M in the solicitation. Just to be sure, does that mean that businesses qualify as 'small' if their annual gross revenue is under \$22.5M?

**Answer #11: For evaluation purposes the primary NAICS is 541310 Architectural Services – size standard is \$11.0M.**
