156.09 Traffic Control Supervisor. Amend as follows:**Add the following to the first sentence:**

Provide a separate traffic control supervisor while performing work simultaneously within two separate parks.

Add the following:

(l) Transport personnel, construction signs, barricades, drums, cones, tubular markers, and other traffic control devices.

(m) Prepare a Traffic Control Plan (TCP) to ensure safe and efficient pedestrian, bicycle, and vehicular circulation (including Park operations and emergency vehicles) during construction. Determine phasing and sequencing of signage to route visitors around construction areas and to day-use parking and other appropriate locations. Provide a description of how pedestrians and bicyclists, and safe vehicle passage is provided through the use of signs, flaggers, and pilot cars. Address access for emergency vehicles, police, school buses, rangers, fire, and disaster units. Include closures of trails to public access in the TCP. Submit plan for CO and Park review and approval 14 days prior to any construction activities impacting public traffic. Maintain and update the TCP throughout the duration of the project and at the request of the CO. Coordinate the TCP with the written construction schedule.

(n) Keep Park visitors out of active construction areas and in designated public pathways.

(o) The traffic control supervisor will not be permitted to operate a pilot car, work as a flagger, laborer, or operator, except to relieve flaggers or pilot car drivers for short periods of time (i.e. a lunch or rest room break), but will be onsite and available at all times to perform the duties as described in this section.
