

STATEMENT OF WORK

Subject

The Federal Bureau of Prisons, Field Acquisition Office in Grand Prairie, Texas, intends to make a single award of a contract with firm-fixed prices for landfill disposal services. All services will be performed in accordance with the requirements outline in this statement of work for the Federal Medical Center (FMC) located in Ayer, Massachusetts. Additional information regarding the Federal Bureau of Prisons and its facilities is located at www.bop.gov.

Place of Performance

Services will be performed at the contractor's disposal facility. The facility must be approved by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Department of Health and Environment, operated in accordance with all Federal, State and Local codes and laws, and meet EPA requirements and standards.

The disposal facility shall be located within a 10-mile (one-way) radius of the FMC.

Scope of Services

FMC Devens will transport garbage and construction debris to the contractor's disposal facility utilizing a government owned vehicle. Upon delivery, the contractor shall assume ownership of all trash, garbage and construction debris from the Government owned containers, which is not hazardous waste as defined by federal, state or local laws or regulations ("Hazardous Waste"), once the unloading at the transfer site is complete. The contractor will be fully responsible for the disposal of the nonhazardous trash, garbage and construction debris materials in a lawful and proper manner. FMC warrants that FMC shall not deliver any Hazardous Waste and title to Hazardous Waste shall remain with FMC at all times.

The Government estimates they will deliver 540 tons per year of solid waste, However, there is no guarantee regarding the estimated tonnage, as quantities will vary on a per delivery, weekly, monthly and yearly basis. The Contractor will be required to provide the Government with documentation of the tonnage for each delivery.

Schedule

The FMC estimates deliveries to the contractor's disposal facility will occur on a weekly basis, Monday thru Friday, between the hours of 8:00a.m. to 4:00 p.m. local time, excluding Federal holidays. It is estimated that there will be three loads per week.

Minimum Qualifications

The contractor must be properly certified and / or licensed to perform waste disposal in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. The contractor agrees to follow all Federal, State and local laws and regulations.

Supplies

The dumpster(s) and compactor(s) will be provided by the Government. All other supplies to be provided by the Contractor.

Inmate Management

The Contractor will not be responsible of the management of inmates. The Contractor should not give anything to an inmate or accept anything from an inmate that does not pertain to the scope of work. If the Contractor personally knows the inmate delivering waste to the landfill, the Contracting Officer's Representative (COR) should be notified immediately.
