1.0 Summary

NOAA's Monterey Bay National Marine Sanctuary Exploration Center requires replacement of a large, double paned exterior window on its second floor. This window was broken, but the frame is undamaged, some remaining glass will need to be removed prior to installation. This facility is located at 35 Pacific Ave, in Santa Cruz, CA 95060. Pictures are included below.

2.0 Background

Sanctuary Exploration Center

Located at 35 Pacific Avenue in Santa Cruz, CA, 95060 the 14,000 ft² Sanctuary Exploration Center (SEC) is the premiere visitor center for MBNMS and for ONMS on the west coast. Its mission is to foster stewardship of Monterey Bay National Marine Sanctuary by connecting visitors to the water, geology, and life within it; to engender appreciation for maritime and cultural resources protected by the sanctuary; and to highlight the role of technology in understanding sanctuary resources.

3.0 Tasks

- 3.1 Clear broken glass from the frame, collect and dispose
- 3.2 Replace double paned glass to specifications

4.0 Specifications

- 4.1 Window is (X1) 71 5/8" X 96" X 107" Rake Shape pattern (see image)
- 4.2 Glass spacing and color configuration: 1/4" Neutral 40 Clear T / 1/2" Mill Air / 1/4" Spandrel HT Warm Grey

5.0 Requirements

- 5.1 Vendor must have proven experience with installation of large windows (over 50 square feet), on second story buildings.
- 5.2 Vendor may make arrangements to see the site for estimation purposes.
