*Q1: It mentions the equipment needs a grounding lug. Does a grounding lug still need to be provided if our equipment is already grounded? Every unit we produce is ran through a series of electrical tests prior to shipment. This includes measuring voltages, running amps, and ensuring the unit is bonded and grounded. These are all done using a multi-meter and captured in our inspection report. The frame of our equipment is galvanized steel. All components are bonded to the unit. Resistance is tested on the unit to ensure it is grounded and typically our Ohm measurement is under 1 Ohm.*

A1: The Government does not require a grounding lug if the equipment is already certified to be grounded.
