SCOPE: The SAF/SA Information Technology Support services provides mission critical operations, sustainment, security, and support for SAF/SA's diverse collection of IT systems. SAF/SA's systems architecture which consists of endpoint devices, servers, and network components are the foundation which allows applications, software, and many complex and unique Operations Research models to function and communicate. This contract will support approximately 230 users whose mission is to provide Air Force senior leadership with independent, objective, and relevant analytic insights and assessments to inform decisions on strategy, investment, and modernization, proposed programs or concepts, force structure, agile combat support, and operational effectiveness.

SAF/SA's IT infrastructure and suite of mission applications help integrate DoD stakeholders including the Office of the Secretary of Defense (OSD), Department of the Air Force, Defense Agencies, Joint Staff, and other DoD Components (e.g., Navy). This integration across stakeholders promotes more effective and efficient force management and resource allocation in support of the National Military Strategy and National Defense Strategy. The SAF/SA mission of studies and analysis has evolved with the support of several key IT support systems and associated applications, as well as data standards. The part of the organization requiring the greatest amount of computational capability and diversity is located inside a SCIF/SAPF with specialized information systems and network architectures. These architectures include LINUX OS high performance computing (HPC) systems with Windows and LINUX clients as well as additional isolated Windows and LINUX systems.
