**Question 1. I understand this is Firm Fixed price, but can department provide some matrix in the terms of hours each FTE worked to provide that 45 scheduled surgery mark?**

Answer 1. It is estimated that each individual surgery will take approximately six hours, plus two hours of pre-operative care and two hours of post-operative care.

**Question 2. Is there any incumbent contractor? If yes, can you please share more information about that.**

Answer 2. Yes, El Paso Southwestern Cardio Vascular Associates, PA.

**Question 3. What is current fill rate?**

Answer 3: This procurement is for services, not full-time equivalents to provide up to a maximum of 45 scheduled surgeries and on-call services, as required, based on patient needs.

**Question 4. Do we need to provide full time heart Surgeon? The reason I am asking because this is personal service contract and to get full time heart Surgeon for \$400,000 / year Or at \$208.33/hr is extremely challenging. If full time heart Surgeon needed, does government intend to change this labor category to non-personal service?**

Answer 4: The Heart Surgeon will need to perform up to 45 scheduled surgical procedures and be available on an emergency basis, 24 hours/7 days per week/365 days per year, should any patient beneficiary require open heart surgery. There is no provision for additional "bonus" or "overtime" pay for after hours or weekend procedures performed.

**Question 5. In section 1.12.3 - Contract provider may expect to be in an on-call status away from the MTF approximately 14 days during the calendar year, exclusive of the weekend call coverage stated in 4.2.4. Commonly this call coverage will commence at 07:00 a.m. and continue for a 24-hour period. On-call shifts are included in the monthly rate.**

Answer 5. Yes, on-call services are covered in the monthly rate.

**Question 6. Is each of the 6 labor categories required to be on-call 14 days/year not including weekends?**

Answer 6. The on-call schedule is calculated as follows:

24 hrs per day for 365 days = 8760 hours

45 surgeries (each surgery takes approximately 10 hours) = 450 surgery hours

8,760 on-call hours minus 450 surgery hours = 8,310 possible on-call hours for each of the six (6) team members..

**Question 7. Will they need to cover two weekends/month as per 1.12.4?**

Answer 7. The team is on-call 24 hours/7 days per week/365 days per year

**Question 8. What is the place of performance for this team?**

Answer 8. William Beaumont Army Medical Center, Ft Bliss TX.

**Question 9. Would they stay in clinic, or, in the hospital while they are not doing surgeries?**

Answer 9. No, the team would only be in the operating room, ICU or cardiac cath lab.

**Question 10. Do they have dedicated office in the hospital?**

Answer 10. No

**Question 11. Where does the physician see post op follow up cases?**

Answer 11. William Beaumont Army Medical Center, Intensive Care Unit and Cardiology Clinic.

**Question 12. Is that in the clinic?**

Answer 12. William Beaumont Army Medical Center, Intensive Care Unit and Cardiology Clinic.

**Question 13. If yes, what's the divide between clinic work and hospital/surgical work?**

Answer 13. None

**Question 14. What are dedicated hours everyday when cardio thoracic team will be available in-person?**

Answer 14. See response to Question 6.
