12. Section 01 35 26, paragraph 1.3.1.1.1 "SSHO Staffing for USACE Dredging Contracts": Delete this paragraph in its entirety and replace with the following:

1.3.1.1.1 SSHO Staffing for USACE Dredging Contracts

- a. Dredging contracts may include several project sites; this contract will require a minimum of one full time SSHO(s) assigned per project site. SSHO may be collateral duty in specific conditions listed below.
- b. Example of one dredging project site is reflected in each of the following:
 - 1) a mechanical dredge, tug(s) and scow(s), scow route, and material placement site; or
 - 2) a hydraulic pipeline dredge, attendant plant, and material placement site; or
 - 3) a hopper dredge (include land-based material placement site - if applicable.)
- c. On individual dredging project sites with a work force of less than eight employees, the SSHO may be a collateral duty, with the same responsibilities of a full time SSHO.

13. Section 01 35 26, paragraph 1.3.1.1.2 “SSHO Requirements for Dredging”: Delete this paragraph in its entirety and replace with the following:

1.3.1.1.2 SSHO Requirements for Dredging

- a. In addition to requirements stated elsewhere in this specification, the SSHO shall be present at the project site, located so they have full mobility and reasonable access to all major work operations, for at least one shift in each 24-hour period when work is being done. The SSHO, or Alternate SSHO, shall be available during all shifts for immediate verbal consultation and notification, either by phone or radio. The SSHO shall be a full-time, dedicated position, except as noted above. The SSHO shall report to a senior project (or corporate) official.
- b. The SSHO shall inspect all work areas and operations during initial set-up and at least monthly observe and provide personal oversight on each shift during dredging operations for projects with many work sites, more often for those with less work sites.
- c. For projects with multiple shifts or when SSHO is temporarily off-site, an Alternate SSHO will be assigned to ensure SSHO coverage for the project at all times work activities are conducted. The Alternate SSHO must meet the same requirements and assume the responsibilities of the project SSHO. The Alternate SSHO position may be a collateral duty.
- d. If the SSHO is off-site for a period longer than 24 hours, a qualified replacement SSHO shall be provided and shall fulfill the same roles and responsibilities as the primary/initial SSHO.

14. Section 01 45 00.15 10, paragraph 1.6.3 “Quality Control (QC)”: Delete the first sentence of this paragraph and replace with the following sentences: “The Contractor shall identify in his/her Quality Control Plan persons assigned as CQC System Manager and Alternate CQC System Manager. These individuals, within the onsite work organization, shall be responsible for overall management of CQC and have the authority to act in all CQC matters for the Contractor”.

15. Section 35 20 23.23, paragraph 1.1 “Scope”: Delete the first sentence of this paragraph and replace with the following sentence: “It is the purpose of these specification to secure for the Government the hire and operation of one cutterhead dredge, with a dredge discharge size not less than 24 inches inside diameter (ID), complete in all respects, including all attendant plant and crew.”

16. 1.2 BID FORM NOTES

a. Bidders shall bid on all items including optional items (see "*Evaluation of Options*" FAR 52.217-5). Failure to bid on all items will result in a non-responsive bid.

b. Bidders shall use the Item No. 0002 unit price to compute the Option Item No. 0003 total price.

c. Any bid may be rejected if the Contracting Officer or his/her authorized representative determines in writing that it is unreasonable as to price. Unreasonableness of price includes not only the total price of the bid, but the prices for individual line items as well. Any bid may be rejected if the prices for any line items or subline items are materially unbalanced (see "*Rejection of Individual Bids*" FAR 14.404-2).

d. THE NOTICE TO PROCEED (NTP): The successful bidder is advised that performance and payment bonds shall be submitted in accordance with the time frame in block 12B of SF 1442 after Notice of Award. The NTP will be issued after verification of acceptable performance and payment bonds. Within 48 hours after issuance of the NTP, the Contractor shall initiate a meeting to discuss the submittal process with the Administrative Contracting Officer or his/her authorized representative. Physical work cannot start until the Resident Management System is set-up, the Accident Prevention Program and other required submittals have been submitted and approved, and all preliminary meetings called for under the contract have been conducted.

f. The unit "job" is a one-time payment for work performed. "Job" is synonymous with the previously used term "lump sum".

1.3 BIDDING

a. The bidder shall select only one bid lot, determined by the class of dredge intended to be used. Bids which are submitted on an inappropriate bid lot will be declared non-responsive.

b. Bidders shall furnish unit prices for all items listed on the schedule of bid items that require unit prices. If the bidder fails to insert a unit price in the appropriate blank for required items but does furnish an extended total or an estimated amount for such items, the Government will deem the unit price to be the quotient obtained by dividing the extended estimated amount for that line item by the quantity. IF THE BIDDER OMITTS BOTH THE UNIT PRICE AND THE EXTENDED ESTIMATED AMOUNT FOR ANY REQUIRED ITEM, THE BID WILL BE DECLARED NON-RESPONSIVE.

1.4 EVALUATION OF BIDS

a. To provide fair competition between dredges of dissimilar sizes and production rates, the hourly dredging quantities have been determined based on the estimated quantity of shoal material to be removed and the nominal production rate of the dredge in each bid lot. The production rates shown in the chart in the paragraph entitled "Minimum Production

Rate Requirements" located in the Dredging Region Section(s) were used to make this determination.

b. The nominal dredge production rates listed in this solicitation were conservatively estimated based on an average "Standard" cross-sectional quantity of material for this solicitation's dredging regions, which have variable and dynamic shoaling conditions. It is the bidder's responsibility to make its own assessment of the actual dredging conditions in order to prepare a bid for this work.

c. Award will be made to that responsible bidder presenting the lowest priced responsive bid in response to this solicitation, regardless of the Bid Lot used.

d. The hourly quantities shown on the bid lots (Bid Items "NOH Dredging" and "NOH Option Dredging") are 100% pay time hours. The actual calendar duration of the contract may vary as a result of fractional pay time. Refer to Section 35 20 23.23, paragraph entitled "Dredging and Option Dredging Items", for additional information.

1.5 **CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT AWARD**

a. Award will be made as a whole to one bidder. The dredge and attendant plant offered in the bidding schedule shall be complete with full operating personnel and in operating status for the contract period. EM 385-1-1, Section 19, "Floating Plant and Marine Activities" shall be complied with at all times. NOTE: All work under these specifications shall be performed in accordance with the provisions of EM 385-1-1 "Army Corps of Engineers Safety and Health Requirements Manual", latest edition.

b. The Government may award the contract at the total bid price, comprised of the base items and option item(s); however, the Government is not obligated to exercise any option item(s).

c. The number of hours stated in the bidding schedule is an estimated quantity. The dredge and attendant plant will be retained for an approximate number of days shown in the table below starting no later than 10 calendar days after issuance of the Notice to Proceed.

The time required for completion of the contract shall be established as the number of calendar days listed in the column entitled "Approximate Number of Contract Days for Item 0002" for the applicable bid lot. In the event Option Item 0003 is fully exercised under the terms of the contract, the time required for completion of the contract shall be extended by the number of calendar days listed in the column entitled "Approximate Number of Contract Days for Option Item 0003" for the applicable bid lot. In the event Option Item 0003 is partially exercised, the contract completion date shall be extended using the following formula:

$$[(\text{partial option hours exercised}) / (\text{option hours listed in bid schedule for applicable bid lot})] \times (\text{calendar days listed in column "Approximate Number of Contract Days for Option Item 0003" for applicable bid lot})$$

d. The bidder shall be capable of providing for assignment of the dredge and all attendant plant, complete and in full operating condition in all respects, and to commence dredging no later than 10 calendar days after issuance of the Notice to Proceed.

1.6 BIDDER QUALIFICATIONS

a. Before the Government will award a contract based on this solicitation, the apparent low bidder shall establish that it is responsible and entitled to award of the contract, by certifying that its dredge meets the appropriate production rate for the dredging region, as listed in the chart in the paragraph entitled "Minimum Production Rate Requirements" located in the Dredging Region Section(s). The dredge must have performed at, or above, the listed production rate for at least 85 percent of the total contract duration, on any contracts that are used to prove plant capability, within three years prior to the bid opening date of this solicitation. Failure to establish the dredge's capability to meet the required production rate will result in a finding of non-responsibility.

b. A bidder may be rejected as non-responsible if it cannot show the necessary capital, experience, or equipment needed to perform the work

described under this solicitation (see "Responsible Prospective Contractors" FAR Subpart 9.1). The bidder must also show that the dredge and attendant plant are not already obligated for the performance of other work which would delay commencement, performance, and completion of the solicited work, and must show that delivery of the dredge and attendant plant to the site of work can be made within the time allowed in the specifications.

c. Bidders must register in the System for Award Management (SAM) database in accordance with FAR 52.204-7-OCT 2018.

1.7 **PRE-AWARD INSPECTION OF PLANT**

a. The apparent low bidder shall make the dredge and attendant plant available for inspection, to determine compliance with these specifications, as soon as practicable after bids are opened, and prior to contract award. If deficiencies are found during the inspection, the bidder will be notified in writing, which may be transmitted by email or facsimile. Upon receipt of such notice, the bidder shall correct all deficiencies at least two calendar days in advance of the projected contract award date.

b. Two calendar days before the projected award date, or upon notification by the bidder that the deficiencies have been corrected, a Government representative will re-inspect the dredge and attendant plant. If at that time the dredge and attendant plant do not meet the requirements of these specifications, the bidder will be rejected as non-responsible.

c. The Government may choose to waive the pre-award inspection if the projected contract award date is less than five calendar days after the bid opening date. Waiver of the pre-award inspection does not relieve the bidder from the requirement to provide a dredge and attendant plant in full compliance with the specifications.

1.8 **OPTION ITEMS**

a. The Government may require the delivery of, in whole or part, any Option Items. The Government may exercise an Option Item by written notice to the Contractor. If the Government activates the Option Item, the activation will occur while the Contractor's equipment is in the work vicinity as described in the applicable Dredging Region Section(s). If Option Dredging Item work is exercised, it shall be performed as a continuance of Dredging Item work, which shall be activated first.

b. No additional mobilization/demobilization will be paid to the Contractor for Option Item work performed within the work region. The Contractor shall commence performance of optional work no more than three calendar days after the time the Contractor receives the Government's Notice to Proceed with the optional work.

PART 1 GENERAL

1.1 SCOPE

This section details specific requirements, which are in addition to the general requirements set forth in the specifications, for the Houma Navigation Canal Dredging Region. The work covered by this section consists of furnishing all labor, materials, and equipment, and performing all work required for dredging in the specified dredging region, except for those measures set forth in other technical portions of the specifications.

1.2 MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

All costs for the work covered under this section shall be included in the contract unit price per hour in the "Houma Dredging" and "Houma Option Dredging" items on the bidding schedule.

1.2.1 Non-Standard Dredging Conditions

The following conditions will be considered non-standard:

- a. Those conditions described in Section 35 20 23.23, paragraph entitled "Dredging in Non-Standard Reaches and Conditions".
- b. Any locations within Houma Navigation Canal where the dredging template from Mile 11.0 to Mile 0.0 yields less than a 150 foot swing width.

3.1 DREDGING

3.1.1 Dredging Region

3.1.1.1 Houma Navigation Canal

a. The authorized dimensions for Houma Navigation Canal are -16 feet Mean Lower Low Water (MLLW) by 150 feet bottom width from approximate Mile 11.0 (Station 1368+50) to Mile 0.0 (Station 1952+27). The Administrative Contracting Officer may issue dredging assignments for all or portions of this dredging region. Each dredging assignment will define the dredging template to be dredged by the Contractor. The dredging template will include the swing width, the side slope, and the specified elevation. The specified elevation in the dredging assignment will not exceed 3 feet below the authorized elevation and may be specified above the authorized dimensions when determined to be beneficial to the Government. Dredging assignments will generally fall between approximate Mile 11.0 and Mile 0.0.

b. Disposal of dredged material shall be at the Government's direction. Approved disposal sites are the single point discharge (SPD) location at Mile 7.9 and the open water disposal site approximately 1500 feet west of the channel centerline, as shown on the Houma Navigation Canal, Terrebonne Bay Maintenance Dredging Plates.

3.1.2 Dredge Discharge Pipeline

The Contractor shall provide 17,000 feet of serviceable floating or submerged pipeline and all associated equipment as directed by the Government. See Section 35 20 23.23, paragraph entitled "Dredge Discharge Pipeline", for additional information regarding pipeline requirements.

3.1.3 Before and After Disposal Surveys

The Contractor shall perform before and after disposal surveys at each disposal discharge location. The "Before" discharge survey shall be taken as close as possible to the start of discharge operations. The "After" discharge surveys shall be taken as soon as possible after discharge operations have ceased and shall adequately cover the entire limits of disposal. All surveys shall be tied/referenced to the centerline of the channel. All notes resulting from these surveys shall be presented to the Contracting Officer's Representative. The before and after disposal surveys shall be furnished to the Government in CAD and PDF formats including plan and section views. Survey data shall also be provided in ASCII XYZ format (easting, northing, elevation). All survey data shall be referenced to NAD83, State Plane Coordinates, LA South 1702 horizontally and MLLW vertically. All disposal surveys shall be submitted and accepted before final payment is made to the Contractor. In addition, the before and after disposal surveys shall be submitted to Mr. Jeff Corbino electronically at Jeffrey.M.Corbino@usace.army.mil.

3.1.4 Before and After Dredging Cross Sections

In addition to the requirements in Section 35 01 50.73, paragraph entitled "Before and After Dredging Cross Sections", the before and after dredging cross sections of the channel shall be taken at approximately 200-foot intervals along the channel, as well as at all utility crossings and at all P.C.'s, P.T.'s, P.I.'s, and P.O.T.'s.

3.1.5 Survey Data

In addition to the requirements in Section 35 01 50.73, paragraph entitled "Survey Data", the Contractor shall promptly plot the channel cross sections on a scale of 1 inch = 30 feet horizontal and 1 inch = 5 feet vertical.

3.1.6 Previous Dredging Contracts

Dredging occurs annually or near annually within segments of this dredging region. Contact the contract personnel listed at the beginning of the specifications for information regarding previous dredging contracts.

3.2 MINIMUM PRODUCTION RATE REQUIREMENTS

a. The following charts show the minimum production rates the dredge must perform at as specified in Section 35 20 23.23, paragraph entitled "Required Production and Dredging Tolerances".

If a dredge's submerged pump becomes inoperable and the Contractor elects to continue dredging, then the Contractor will be allowed to operate without the submerged pump provided the specifications have a bid lot for that size dredge without a submerged pump and provided the dredge meets the minimum production rate shown on the chart above and as specified in Section 35 20 23.23, paragraph entitled "Required Production and Dredging Tolerances". For a dredge with an inoperable submerged pump, the new unit price per hour for "Houma Dredging" and "Houma Option Dredging" shall be computed as follows:

Union Rate Identifiers

A four letter classification abbreviation identifier enclosed in dotted lines beginning with characters other than "SU" or "UAVG" denotes that the union classification and rate were prevailing for that classification in the survey. Example: PLUM0198-005 07/01/2014. PLUM is an abbreviation identifier of the union which prevailed in the survey for this classification, which in this example would be Plumbers. 0198 indicates the local union number or district council number where applicable, i.e., Plumbers Local 0198. The next number, 005 in the example, is an internal number used in processing the wage determination. 07/01/2014 is the effective date of the most current negotiated rate, which in this example is July 1, 2014.

Union prevailing wage rates are updated to reflect all rate changes in the collective bargaining agreement (CBA) governing this classification and rate.

Survey Rate Identifiers

Classifications listed under the "SU" identifier indicate that no one rate prevailed for this classification in the survey and the published rate is derived by computing a weighted average rate based on all the rates reported in the survey for that classification. As this weighted average rate includes all rates reported in the survey, it may include both union and non-union rates. Example: SULA2012-007 5/13/2014. SU indicates the rates are survey rates based on a weighted average calculation of rates and are not majority rates. LA indicates the State of Louisiana. 2012 is the year of survey on which these classifications and rates are based. The next number, 007 in the example, is an internal number used in producing the wage determination. 5/13/2014 indicates the survey completion date for the classifications and rates under that identifier.

Survey wage rates are not updated and remain in effect until a new survey is conducted.

Union Average Rate Identifiers

Classification(s) listed under the UAVG identifier indicate that no single majority rate prevailed for those classifications; however, 100% of the data reported for the classifications was union data. EXAMPLE: UAVG-OH-0010 08/29/2014. UAVG indicates that the rate is a weighted union average rate. OH indicates the state. The next number, 0010 in the example, is an internal number used in producing the wage determination. 08/29/2014 indicates the survey completion date for the classifications and rates under that identifier.

A UAVG rate will be updated once a year, usually in January of each year, to reflect a weighted average of the current negotiated/CBA rate of the union locals from which the rate is based.

WAGE DETERMINATION APPEALS PROCESS

1.) Has there been an initial decision in the matter? This can be:

- * an existing published wage determination
- * a survey underlying a wage determination
- * a Wage and Hour Division letter setting forth a position on a wage determination matter
- * a conformance (additional classification and rate) ruling

On survey related matters, initial contact, including requests for summaries of surveys, should be with the Wage and Hour Regional Office for the area in which the survey was conducted because those Regional Offices have responsibility for the Davis-Bacon survey program. If the response from this initial contact is not satisfactory, then the process described in 2.) and 3.) should be followed.

With regard to any other matter not yet ripe for the formal process described here, initial contact should be with the Branch of Construction Wage Determinations. Write to:
