JOINT VENTURE PARTNER/SUBCONTRACTOR CONSENT LETTER
FOR THE RELEASE OF PAST PERFORMANCE INFORMATION
TO THE PRIME CONTRACTOR

Past performance information concerning joint venture partners/subcontractors cannot be disclosed to a private party without the joint venture partner's/subcontractor's consent. Because a prime contractor is a private party, the Government will need that consent before disclosing joint venture partners'/subcontractors' past and present performance information to the prime contractor during exchanges. In an effort to assist the Government's past performance evaluation team in assessing your recent past performance relevancy and confidence, we request that the following consent letter be completed by the joint venture partners/major subcontractors identified in your proposal. The completed consent letters should be submitted as part of your Past Performance Volume.
