

SCOPE OF WORK AND GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS FOR GENERAL WHEELCHAIRS

1. Background

The Oklahoma City VA Health Care System (OKC VAHCS) must purchase additional wheelchairs which can be utilized safely by transports, medical staff, and visitors throughout the facility.

Project Scope

The OKC VAHCS must purchase ten (10) wheelchairs which meet the needs of the Lawton Main and Lawton North CBOC medical facilities.

2. Specifications

The Oklahoma City VAHCS specifications are designed to outline all the Oklahoma City VAHCS Nursing Service requirements. These requirements will be provided to the Contracting Officer before final approval. The wheelchairs are provided below:

- Offeror must meet these specifications:

Wheelchair must be pink:

- Non-collapsible (non-folding)
- Width 27"
- Length 38"
- Back Height 22"
- Max. Occupancy Weight 600lbs
- Seat Width 20"
- Seat to Floor 21.7"
- Weight 57lbs
- Arm Rests -Steel oval tubing covered in a non-porous sleeve. Lift for easy transfer.
- Frame -Formed oval tubing; durable robotic welding; mar-resistant paint.
- Wheels -2 1/8" (54mm) composite wheel. 8" (203mm) diameter. Non-marking.
- Brake -Automatic; Fail Safe Ratchet, with handle control, will release when grasping the handle, and automatically apply when the handle is released
- Casters -5" (127mm). Urethane, Sealed bearing. Non-marring, anti-tip mechanism
- Footrests -Steel. Non-Removable. Lifts for comfort.
- Cushion -PU Coated, Fire Retardant.
- Storage space for items weighing up to 25 lbs.
- Must be able to "nest" within each other for storage
- Nesting dimensions- Nest with cushion- 12", First Chair 41"
- Weight capacity up to 600lbs
- Including cushion, oxygen tank holder & leg rest that fits chair & can be elevated
- Custom name plate (with VA name and address)
- Security pole with flag
