The quantities of supplies or services specified in the Schedule are estimates only and are not purchased by this contract. Except as this contract may otherwise provide, if the Government's requirements do not result in orders in the quantities described as "estimated" or "maximum" in the Schedule, that fact shall not constitute the basis for an equitable price adjustment.

(b) Delivery or performance shall be made only as authorized by orders issued in accordance with the Ordering clause. Subject to any limitations in the Order Limitations clause or elsewhere in this contract, the Contractor shall furnish to the Government all supplies or services specified in the Schedule and called for by orders issued in accordance with the Ordering clause. The Government may issue orders requiring delivery to multiple destinations or performance at multiple locations.

(c) Except as this contract otherwise provides, the Government shall order from the Contractor all the supplies or services specified in the Schedule that are required to be purchased by the Government activity or activities specified in the Schedule.

(d) The Government is not required to purchase from the Contractor requirements in excess of any limit on total orders under this contract.

(e) If the Government urgently requires delivery of any quantity of an item before the earliest date that delivery may be specified under this contract, and if the Contractor will not accept an order providing for the accelerated delivery, the Government may acquire the urgently required goods or services from another source.

(f) Any order issued during the effective period of this contract and not completed within that period shall be completed by the Contractor within the time specified in the order. The contract shall govern the Contractor's and Government's rights and obligations with respect to that order to the same extent as if the order were completed during the contract's effective period; provided, that the Contractor shall not be required to make any deliveries under this contract after 09-30-2027.

The Government may require continued performance of any services within the limits and at the rates specified in the contract. I. **TITLE:** Air Handler Filter Maintenance

II. **OBJECTIVE**

Contractor shall provide all supervision, labor, equipment, materials, supplies, and transportation to maintain and service VA Loma Linda Healthcare System (VALLHCS) air handler filters. Service shall consist of periodic replacement of filters and emergency responses for 61 air handler units located at VALLHCS (See attached equipment spreadsheet). Filters shall be maintained in optimum condition in accordance with respective equipment's operating manual and National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) Code 2001. Inspection certificates shall be displayed as appropriate.

III. **SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS:**

The following guidelines shall be used:

- Contractor shall replace filters as required. Goal is to improve indoor air quality and reduce operational costs.
- All filters shall be installed with a neoprene seal, using a minimum of 4 clips per filter.
- Air Handlers shall have labels documenting filter type, quantity, and date replaced.
- Filters needed in the basement, rooftops, and penthouses must be hand carried up and down staircases since no elevators access these areas.
- Air handlers located in the main facility service bays are accessed through public hallways. Proper containers shall be used for transporting new and used filters throughout the facility.
- All used filters shall be removed from VA Loma Linda and disposed of properly.
- Contractor shall create and maintain a log documenting the location, filter type, pressure drops, date filter was replaced, and any unusual observations.
- Contractor shall store filters off-site at a facility of their choosing. COR may make exceptions on a case-by-case basis.
- Contractor shall respond within 24 hours for emergency requests.
- Supervisor/lead technician on-site shall be a NAFA Certified Air Filter Specialist" (CAFS).
- Contractor shall have ability to certify Bag-In/Bag-Out housings after HEPA's are replaced.

Note: Only service elevators located in the FMS annex are authorized for maintenance personnel.

IV. RESPONSE TO EMERGENCY SERVICE REQUESTS:

- a. Contractor must respond to requests for emergency service in the following manner:
 1. A competent service representative adequately equipped with tools, test instruments, and repair parts will arrive at the VALLHCS within the designated response time.
 2. The competent service representative will be prepared to begin work immediately to resolve the complaint as expressed by the COR, POC, or designee when service was requested. Work required to resolve the complaint will continue without interruption until problem is resolved.
 3. Service representative will come equipped with all the service/technical manuals needed to perform the work.
- b. Service representative may contact VA staff by phone before arrival at the VALLCS. Such contacts, however, will not serve to alter the requirements for arrival on-site except when the request for service is withdrawn by the VALLHCS.
- c. The designated response time for this contract is 24 hours from the time of the request for service. If repeated requests are made before the arrival of contractor's repairer, the first request will determine the required time of arrival.
- d. All requests for repair service will be considered requests for emergency service unless a statement to the contrary is made by the COR, POC, or designee. Such statements will be documented on the service report
